National Conference on “Reproductive Health”

The College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan (CPSP) is holding a one-day National Conference on Reproductive Health (RH) on May 27, 2010 from 9am to 5 pm.

The conference is a continuity of CPSP Reproductive Health activities, which started with adoption of RH as a theme in mid 1994 in order to improve the health status of the women in Pakistan. The efforts of CPSP culminated in the form of separate curricula for undergraduate and postgraduate medical teaching. But there is still much to be done to qualitatively improve the RH care in Pakistan. CPSP considering that it is high time that we revisit and reinforce the efforts regarding RH, has decided to hold this conference.

The Conference will be held primarily at CPSP Karachi, but will be beamed simultaneously through video-conference, to Regional Centers Lahore, Islamabad, Peshawar, Multan, Quetta, Faisalabad and Hyderabad to enable maximum participation across the country. There is no registration fee for the conference.

Participants will be given certificate and CME credit hours for attending the conference. However, due to the limited number of seats at each center, the doctors desirous to attend the conference are advised to register as early as possible. Registration will be closed at each center as soon as its capacity is filled.
