

Joint meeting of Medicine and Allied Faculties

In his introductory remarks, the President reiterated that College would remain steadfast in up gradation of examination standards. The decision to change the format of theory paper towards MCQs was in the same directions. The participants gave their feedback regarding the matter.

The structure of Intermediate Module training in Medicine and Allied specialties was discussed in detail. President talked about the CPSP Competency Model, the Star program for induction, curriculum, training, monitoring and evaluation.

Structured Visual Curriculum Display Charts facilitate the residents in learning about that specialty training program at greater depths.

CPSP had introduced the E-Log for individual training programs and residents as well as their supervisors are required to log and add the relevant information at regular intervals.

Talking about International Collaborations, President shared the good news of acquiring ACGME Accreditation for CME programs. This milestone is historical, he said.

The President assured the participants that College would continue to facilitate the up gradation of individual training centers by means of inspection teams. The participating Deans / Conveners / Focal persons/ Secretaries were advised to contact relevant department at CPSP.
