

NOTIFICATION

GUIDELINES FOR FELLOWSHIP TRAINEES IN ORTHODONTICS

All Fellowship trainees in Orthodontics are required to fulfill the under-mentioned requirements for the purpose of appearing in examination.

1. It is mandatory for every prospective candidate of FCPS-II examination, to upload their five finished case records on E-Log book from September 2018.
 - a. Candidates having manual log book, from 2010 or earlier, will upload five finished cases before appearing in clinical / practical examination scheduled in September 2018 session. I.T. department will provide temporary E-Log I.D. to these candidates on request.
 - b. Candidates already making routine entries and scheduled to appear in September 2018 examination will upload their five finished cases before appearing in clinical / practical examination.
 - c. From 2019, all candidates shall make entries of the routine work done in the generic E-Log book and shall also upload five finished cases at the time of application for appearing in theory examination. This will be mandatory eligibility requirement for appearing in theory and clinical / practical examination.
 - d. The five cases selected should be traceable in the entries made in the generic E-Logbook. However, candidates can start with as many treated cases as they want (maximum 15) to fulfill the required E-Log criteria. The uploaded treated case records should be in accordance with the CPSP case template.
2. There is a provision to upload fifteen (15) cases on E-Log book. However, a candidate will be allowed to present only five cases in examination out of those fifteen cases.
3. Candidates having started their training from July 2018 onwards, will upload frontal picture of each case at the start of treatment. They must make entries in time; no one is allowed to make E-Log book entries older than 3 months.
